Riding the School Bus



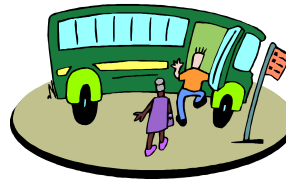
Welcome

A school bus is an extension of the classroom—and the same conduct your teachers expect to see from you in class is what the bus drivers expect to see from you on board.

Below are some safety tips for riding:

- Be at your bus stop 5-10 minutes before pick-up time.
- Be a **safe pedestrian**. Walk on the sidewalk where available, cross the street at appropriate places and **look both ways** before crossing
- Stand at least 6 feet back from the road. Please don't push or shove your buddies at the bus stop.
- Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop and the doors to open completely before you board.
- Board the bus in single file and **hold on** to the handrail.

- Carry your stuff in a backpack so your hands are free.
- The bus driver is in charge of the vehicle and the passengers. **Listen to and be respectful of the bus driver.**



Do and Don'ts

- **Do** be at your bus stop 5-10 minutes before the scheduled time.
- **Do** be ready to keep your backpack or other gear on your lap or under the seat in front of you.
- **Do** be **respectful** of your shared space. Keep your voice down so the driver can concentrate on the road.
- No swearing, horseplay or roughhousing.
- **Do** not touch safety equipment or emergency exits unless it is an emergency.
- **Do** keep your hands, arms, feet, head and belongings inside the vehicle at all times.
- **Do remain seated** for the whole ride and until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- **Do** not throw things in the bus or out

of the bus.

- **Do follow instructions** from the bus driver, monitor and safety patroller.
- **Do respect private properties** when waiting for the bus and don't leave your garbage behind.
- **Do** refrain from eating, drinking and smoking on the bus.



- **Do** not bring alcohol, drugs or weapons onto the school bus.
- **Do** learn the name of your bus company and run number so you don't get on the wrong bus.

Student Discipline

For those who choose not to comply with the above, discipline for conduct on the school bus falls under the authority of the principal.

The bus driver is required to report incidents on board the school bus to the bus company and the principal. The principal may talk to you and/or your parents.

You may be subject to in-school discipline or even a suspension or removal from the school bus. Remember, riding the school bus is your privilege, not a right. Like any privilege, it can be taken away.
