### Internal Policy Statement

STS will consider hazard designations when the features of the area are such as they would typically alter the way a community uses the area and where it would not be reasonable to expect student movement. STS will factor in whether other community controls are present that would reasonably increase safety.

STS is solely responsible for the designation of a hazard area and the decision is final and not subject to appeal.

Hazard designations are reviewed periodically and may be removed as conditions change.

### Procedure

When considering a hazardous area, STS will consider the following factors:

- Age of the Students
- Traffic Volume
- Posted Speed Limits
- Number of Travelled Lanes
- Sightlines
- Intersections
- Travel Conditions
- Physical Barriers
- Grade of Road or Curve of Roadway
- Land Use
