5.1 Emergency Transportation	1 of 1	March 2009

Policy Statement

In rare circumstances, arrangements for transportation may be made that are beyond the scope of home to school transportation for a bona fide emergency situation where the safety and welfare of the student could be compromised if left unaltered.

The application of this policy is at the sole discretion of the Principal and would provide authorization for a student to be dropped off at a stop different from the student's regular designated stop but on the same route.

Procedure

The parent/guardian will contact the school with the nature of the emergency and the principal will be the sole determinant with respect to the validity of the emergency. Situations like "running late" and "stuck in traffic" are not considered to be emergency situations under the application of this policy.
