- Resumed in Person First Rider Day Programming, with sites in Woodstock, St Thomas, Strathroy and 2 in London. 378 families participated in the event! STS provides continuous access to digital/online First Rider and Bus Safety resources.
- Provided in-school bus safety training with Intertrain (Buster the Bus) for all TVDSB and LDCSB students.
- Collaborated with school bus contractors to address a bus driver shortage, ensuring that all students had bus service for the first day of school. Continued to support the recruitment of Bus Drivers through Social Media and Website campaigns and a Become a Bus Driver application on the STS website.
- Undertook a strategic route review in order to retain or improve service delivery standards for students and families while minimizing driver shortage impacts.
