- Student transportation services were launched successfully for the opening of the 25-26 school year, with high registration rates and all drivers completing route familiarization before the first day
- Strategic route planning reviews allowed service to be reallocated to growing schools, minimizing the need for additional routes while maintaining service standards
- Collaborated with bus contractors to address driver shortages, ensuring full service coverage; continued recruitment efforts through digital campaigns via social media and the STS website
- Provided families with access to the STS Parent Portal, newsletters, and a digital safety education to support back-to-school readiness
- Delivered First Rider Day programming at 5 sites across the district, students practiced bus safety and riding procedures
- Local bus operators partnered with law enforcement for school bus safety enforcement and STS ran social media campaigns focused on school bus safety for back to school and School Bus Safety Week in October
- Installed walking wayfinding signs in neighbourhoods at 12 schools in collaboration ASRTS; continued in school student-led safety programs through CAA initiatives
- Supported charter transportation for district-wide events and field trips, including athletics and special programs


