**Shortage of school bus drivers amid pandemic continues to temporarily disrupt services**

Southwestern Ontario Student Transportation Services (STS) is reminding families of the continued bus route disruptions due to the ongoing decrease of available bus drivers resulting from COVID-19.

Every effort is being made to communicate cancellations as quickly as possible to minimize risk to students. Parents and guardians are asked to prepare alternate transportation arrangements in the event of school bus service disruptions due to bus driver shortages.

In the event of school bus route cancellations, the contractors will post the cancellations to the website as early as possible, per the normal practice. Families can choose from the following sources to find out about service disruptions:

- Check [mybigyellowbus.ca](https://mybigyellowbus.ca) frequently – make it a regular part of your morning and afternoon routine.
- Download the **BusPlanner Delays** app and subscribe to your student's bus run for push notifications.

March 11, 2022**

**Provincial COVID Update – Lifting of Restrictions**

On March 9, 2022, the Ministry of Education announced that certain COVID-related instructions were to change. STS is committed to providing a safe environment while delivering transportation services for students. The Ministry of Education's update is reflected in a number of areas below. We wish to highlight the following major changes:

- Masks are no longer mandatory for any students on yellow bus, wheelchair bus or vans.
- Enhanced cleaning twice a day will continue to occur on all vehicles.
- Seating plans and cohorting are no longer mandatory, however the driver may choose to continue with the seating plan to encourage safe riding behaviour.
- Drivers and students are still required to self-screen before getting on the bus.
- PPE will continue to be provided to drivers until the end of the school year.
- Rapid Antigen Tests will continue to be provided to drivers.
- STS encourages drivers and students to continue using strategies to protect themselves from COVID such as masking, good hand and respiratory hygiene, etc.

STS will continue to work with our bus operators, LDCSB, and TVDSB to ensure everyone has a safe ride to and from school. For more info about student safe practices on the bus visit [Student Bus Safety Practices](#)

**School Bus Driver Shortages**

With students returning to in-person learning on Monday January 17, 2022, Southwestern Ontario Student Transportation Services (STS) advises that a shortage of school bus drivers may have an impact on school bus operations in the City of London and Middlesex, Oxford and Elgin Counties if school bus drivers are absent. Unfortunately, there is not the supply of spare bus drivers as in the past to cover all routes where a bus driver may be required to be off work for a number of days.

Parents and guardians are asked to prepare alternate transportation arrangements in the event of school bus service disruptions.

In the event of school bus route cancellations, the contractors will post the cancellations to the website as early as possible, per the normal practice. Families can choose from the following sources to find out about service disruptions:

- Check [mybigyellowbus.ca](https://mybigyellowbus.ca) frequently – make it a regular part of your morning and afternoon routine.
- Download the **BusPlanner Delays** app and subscribe to your student's bus run for push notifications.
- Subscribe for emails in the Parent Portal at [mybigyellowbus.ca](https://mybigyellowbus.ca)

If a school bus route does not have a permanent driver and there is an insufficient list of supply drivers, the route could be cancelled for multiple days. In such instances, STS will provide special notification to the parents/guardians of the students assigned to the affected run(s).

## STS NEWS UPDATE December 1, 2021



With winter weather upon please ensure you stay up to date on where to find Bus Delay and Cancellation notifications.

### **CANCELLATIONS**

The decision to cancel school bus runs due to inclement weather rests with the school bus companies. Cancellations will be posted to [www.mybigyellowbus.ca](http://www.mybigyellowbus.ca) by 6:30 am on the morning of the inclement weather event.

- In the event of bus cancellations due to FOG, buses will be cancelled in the morning but will operate in the afternoon as scheduled unless otherwise posted
- In the event of bus cancellations due to any other kind of inclement weather, bus cancellations are in effect for the entire day

### **OPERATIONAL DELAYS**

On-road/operational bus delays are posed by the bus operator to [www.mybigyellowbus.ca](http://www.mybigyellowbus.ca) once a bus is reasonably expected to be delayed in real time.

- On route delays may occur for reasons such as mechanical issues, traffic congestion, poor driving conditions, construction, late departures from schools, etc.
- Times are approximate, noting that buses delayed while on route may be able to make up the time on the route.
- Parents may view the website, subscribe to emails for their child specific bus via the STS Parent Portal, or receive alerts for their child's bus via the BusPlanner Delays App.

Add [notifications@mybigyellowbus.ca](mailto:notifications@mybigyellowbus.ca) to your safe senders list to avoid spam filters.



Download the free BusPlanner Delay app (available for Android & iOS)  
End-users are responsible for the correct use of the app, including selecting preferred settings, entering the correct school & bus run information and updating the app when new versions are released.  
STS cannot provide support to people experiencing difficulty with the app on their personal device as it does not have access to nor control your personal device settings.



#### **BEFORE you subscribe for emails or download the app, YOU NEED TO KNOW:**

1. Your Student's ID Number (available from the school office)
2. Your Student's Bus Run Number. (in the Parent Portal at [www.mybigyellowbus.ca](http://www.mybigyellowbus.ca))
3. Know the Bus Company who transports your Student. (in the Parent Portal at [www.mybigyellowbus.ca](http://www.mybigyellowbus.ca))
4. Know the Phone Number for the bus company. (in the Parent Portal at [www.mybigyellowbus.ca](http://www.mybigyellowbus.ca))
5. **SAVE** all of the above in your smartphone.

**School Bus Driver Shortages**

## STS NEWS UPDATE September 2, 2021

### **Possible Bus Driver Shortages**

Like many other school districts throughout the province, school bus contractors servicing the London District Catholic School Board and Thames Valley District School Board have experienced Bus Driver Shortages in the past. School Bus Contractors have shared that due to active recruitment in the area, they are not experiencing many shortages at this time. Due to continuing changes related to the COVID-19 pandemic, conditions could change with very short notice to families and schools. In the event of possible service disruptions, please see below information about communications of school bus service disruptions. Schools will remain open due to School Bus Driver Shortages, so we ask that families have a backup transportation in place.

## **STS NEWS UPDATE** **August 31, 2021**

As we prepare for the upcoming school year there are a few items that require your attention:

### **Parent Portal**

The [Parent Portal](#) is now open on the [mybigyellowbus](#) website. Families who registered for transportation must login and check their transportation details.

**The first day of school is Tuesday, September 7.** STS will continue to make routing changes to address bus loads right up to the start of school – check the Parent Portal the weekend before school starts to confirm pick up times.

**To set up a Parent Portal account, follow the [instructions](#). There are also [troubleshooting tips](#) in case you encounter any difficulties.**

Bus routes normally take a while to settle over the first couple weeks of September and we expect this year will require even more time for routines to be established. Please be patient with your bus driver as everyone adapts to the changes required for the fall.

Buses may run off schedule or late for many reasons during the first few weeks. **Download the [BusPlanner Notifications App](#) to receive notifications about your bus sent to your smartphone to stay informed.** You will need to know the Bus Run number from the Parent Portal before you set up the app.

If you do not have access to the internet, the school can provide your transportation information over the phone. School offices are open now.

### **Face Masks**

**Face masks or face coverings must be worn on vehicles for students in Kindergarten – Grade 12.** Parents/guardians or caregivers who assist students to and from special needs vehicles must also wear a mask. The full [policy](#) is posted online.
